RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS FOR THE
GOVERNING BODY OF THE
TOWN OF WHEATLAND

A special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Wheatland, County of Platte, State of Wyoming was held in the Council Room of the Town Hall at 5:00 P.M., Wednesday, October 1, 2003, for discussion on an application for a malt beverage permit for the Chamber of Commerce, financing sanitation equipment and airport update.

Mayor Dingman called the meeting to order and upon roll call it was found that the following were present; Councilmen Wilhelm, Hensel, Geile and Wilson. Also present was Clerk/Treasurer, Cindy Kahler.

Mayor Dingman presented the agenda and a motion was made by Councilman Wilhelm and seconded by Councilman Geile to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

Mayor Dingman presented an application from the Platte County Chamber of Commerce for a malt beverage permit to sell beer at their annual fund raiser to be held on October 4, 2003. A motion was made by Councilman Wilhelm and seconded by Councilman Geile to approve the application from the Chamber of Commerce for a malt beverage permit for October 4, 2003 for the hours of 6:00 P.M. to 10:00 P.M., at the 4-H building. Mayor Dingman called for the vote, voting yes- Councilman Wilhelm, Hensel & Geile, voting no - Councilman Wilson. Mayor Dingman declared the motion carried 3-1

Clerk/Treasurer, Cindy Kahler reported that interest quotations had been received from all of the financial institutions in Wheatland and the lowest quote was from Wells Fargo at 2.620% interest for 36 months to finance the automated sanitation system. A motion was made by Councilman Wilson and seconded by Councilman Hensel to approve the financing for the sanitation equipment through the Wells Fargo Bank and authorize the Mayor to execute the documents. Motion carried 4-0.

Clerk/Treasurer, Cindy Kahler stated that she had contacted the airport engineers and they indicated the plans and specifications for the refurbishing of the old runway should be in her office before the next regular Council meeting. She indicated that the plan is to crack seal the runway this fall and seal coat it in the spring, but there will be more information on the plans.

With no further business to come before the governing body, Mayor Dingman adjourned the meeting at 4:26 P.M., the next regular meeting of the Town Council will be October 13, 2003.
