RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS FOR THE  
GOVERNING BODY OF THE  
TOWN OF WHEATLAND

A special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Wheatland, County of Platte, State of Wyoming was held in the Council Room of the Town Hall for the purpose of a public hearing on a Community Development Block Grant application for the S.E. Wyoming Mental Health Center and proposed Ordinance No. 702, on Wednesday, June 2, 2004 at 4:30 P.M..

Mayor Dingman called the meeting to order and upon roll call it was found that the following were present; Councilmen - Wilhelm, Hensel and Wilson. Also present was Clerk/Treasurer, Cindy Kahler, Deputy Clerk/Treasurer, Sandy Lipps, WADCO representative, Jan Kahler, S.E. Mental Health Center representatives, Steve Mincer and Christine Rector.

Mayor Dingman presented the agenda and a motion was made by Councilman Hensel and seconded by Councilman Wilhelm to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Dingman opened the public hearing for the Community Development Block Grant application at 4:30 P.M.. S.E. Mental Health Center Director, Steve Mincer stated that the Mental Health Center would like to build a new facility in Wheatland that will serve all of Platte County. He indicated that the preliminary costs presented by the architectural firm is \$750,000.00. The grant request is for \$300,000.00 and the Mental Health Center would then be obligated to fund the remaining \$450,000.00. WADCO representative, Jan Kahler stated that their office is presently researching other avenues of funding for this project. There was a discussion concerning the size and type of facility that is being planned. Mayor Dingman asked for public comment regarding the application from the S.E.Wyo. Mental Health Center for a Community Development Block Grant in the amount of \$300,000.00. There being none, Mayor Dingman closed the public hearing at 4:45 P.M..

Mayor Dingman presented proposed Ordinance No. 702 on second reading. A motion was made by Councilman Hensel and seconded by Councilman Wilhelm to approve proposed Ordinance No. 702 on second reading. Voting yes - Councilman Wilhelm, Councilman Hensel and Mayor Dingman, Voting no - Councilman Wilson. Mayor Dingman declared the motion carried 3-1. Ordinance No. 702 title being as follows:

AN ORDINANCE TO CONTINUE THE IMPOSITION  
OF THE OPTIONAL ONE CENT SALES TAX PURSUANT  
TO W.S. 39-15-203, WYOMING STATUTES AS AMENDED.

With no further business to come before the governing body, Mayor Dingman adjourned the meeting at 4:50 P.M.. The next regular meeting of the Town Council will be held on June 14, 2004 at 7:00 P.M..
