RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS FOR THE
GOVERNING BODY OF THE
TOWN OF WHEATLAND

A special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Wheatland, Platte County, State of Wyoming, was held in the Council Room of the Town Hall at 4:30 P.M., on Thursday, October 28, 2004 for the purpose of a public hearing on a liquor license transfer application.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dingman and upon roll call it was found that the following were present; Councilmen Wilhelm, Hensel and Geile. Also present was Clerk/Treasurer, Cindy Kahler, Deputy Clerk/Treasurer, Sandy Lipps, Mr. & Mrs. Laramie Cole and Harvey Cozad.

Mayor Dingman stated that the agenda as advertised was a public hearing for an application from Laramie J. Cole and Titania Cole to transfer the liquor license presently held by Harvey Cozad for the Landmark Bar. A motion was made by Councilman Geile and seconded by Councilman Wilhelm to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Dingman asked Deputy Clerk/Treasurer, Sandy Lipps if all of the documents had been filed properly and she indicated that they had been reviewed by the Town's Attorney and the Wyoming Liquor Commission and everything was in order.

After a brief discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Hensel and seconded by Councilman Geile to approve the application to transfer the liquor license held by Harvey Cozad for the Landmark Bar to Laramie and Titania Cole. Mayor Dingman called for a roll call vote; Councilman Wilhelm-yes, Councilman Hensel-yes, Councilman Geile-yes, Mayor Dingman-yes. Mayor Dingman declared the motion carried.

With no further business to come before the governing body, Mayor Dingman adjourned the meeting at 4:40 P.M.. The next regular meeting of the Town Council will be held on November 8, 2004.
