RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS FOR THE
GOVERNING BODY OF THE
TOWN OF WHEATLAND

A special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Wheatland, Platte County, State of Wyoming was held in the Council Room of the Town Hall at 4:30 P.M., Thursday, May 11, 2006 for the purpose of a public hearing on a liquor license transfer and a budget amendment.

Mayor Dingman called the meeting to order and upon roll call it was found that the following were present; Councilmen Wilhelm, Hensel and Wilson, Councilwoman Allen. Also present were Clerk/Treasurer, Cindy Kahler and Deputy Clerk/Treasurer, Sandy Lipps.

A motion was made by Councilman Wilhelm and seconded by Councilwoman Allen to approve the agenda as advertised. Motion carried 4-0.

Mayor Dingman opened the public hearing on a liquor license transfer application from Rick L. Bowen d/b/a Commodore Bar to ROBO LLC. Mayor Dingman stated that ROBO LLC represented Heidi Rothenbuehler, John Rothenbuehler and Rick L. Bowen. Mayor Dingman asked if there were any comments regarding the transfer. There being none, a motion was made by Councilman Wilson and seconded by Councilwoman Allen to approve the transfer of the liquor license from Rick L. Bowen to ROBO LLC d/b/a Commodore Bar. Motion carried 4-0.

A Resolution for the reappropriation of funds for the July 1, 2005 to June 30, 2006. A motion was made by Councilman Wilhelm and seconded by Councilman Hensel to approve the Resolution for reappropriation of funds for July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006 as presented. Motion carried 4-0. The Resolution is as follows:

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE REAPPROPRIATION
OF FUNDS FOR THE TOWN OF WHEATLAND, WYOMING FOR
THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 2005 AND
ENDING JUNE 30, 2006.

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated various funds within the budget to avoid over expenditure of said funds; and, the sum reappropriated within the budget is One Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars and No Cents. (\$170,000.00).

General Fund

Department expenditures will exceed revenue by \$90,000.00. Transfer will need to be necessary to

Administration - \$90,000.00. Excess funds in the amount of \$90,000.00 will be transferred from the General Fund Reserve Account.

Severance Tax

All expenditures are within budgeted amounts.
No transfer will be necessary.

Electric Fund

All expenditures are within budgeted amounts
No transfer will be necessary

Sanitation Fund

All expenditures are within budgeted amounts.
No transfer will be necessary.

Water Fund

Department expenditures will exceed revenue by \$80,000.00. Excess funds in the amount of \$80,000.00 will be transferred from the General Fund Reserve Account.

Sewer Fund

All expenditures are within budgeted amounts.
No transfer will be necessary.

Section 2. This resolution will be in full force and effect from and after this passage.
