RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS FOR THE  
GOVERNING BODY OF THE  
TOWN OF WHEATLAND

A special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Wheatland, Platte County, State of Wyoming was held in the Council Room of the Town Hall at 5:00 P.M., Tuesday, August 19, 2008 for the purpose of discussion on the "Main Street Program" and a catering permit application.

Mayor Hensel called the meeting to order and upon roll call it was found that the following were present; Councilmen Madsen, Geile, Evans and Shoemaker. Also present was Town Clerk /Treasurer, Cindy Kahler and Deputy Clerk/Treasurer, Sandy Lipps.

Mayor Hensel introduced Linda Fabian, representing the Heart and Soul Committee that was formed recently to support the businesses and the citizens in Platte County. She stated that they have been meeting on a weekly basis and are working on a number of projects, one of which is a pilot project of a county wide "Main Street Program". Mrs. Fabian introduced Evan Medley, State Program Manager for the Wyoming Main Street Program. Mr. Evan gave a brief presentation on the program and indicated it is designed as a three tier program, beginning with Tier 3; Aspiring Community Program, Tier 2 - Affiliate Community Program and Tier 1 - Certified Main Street Program. He stated that there are presently six Certified Main Street communities in Wyoming and several more that are in the Aspiring Community Program. He stated that a County wide Aspiring Community Program would be a pilot project and it would take the support of all of the communities and the County. He stated there is no monetary obligation with the Aspiring Community program to any of the communities involved. After further discussion, a motion was made by Councilman Shoemaker and seconded by Councilman Geile to send a letter of support to participate in the Wyoming Main Street Program at the Aspiring Community Program level. Motion carried 4-0.

Mayor Hensel presented a catering permit application from the Commodore Bar for a wedding reception on September 6, 2008 at the 4-H Building. A motion was made by Councilman Madsen and seconded by Councilman Geile to approve the catering permit application from the Commodore Bar for September 6, 2008 with the applicable fees. Motion carried 4-0.

With no further business to come before the Governing Body, Mayor Hensel adjourned the meeting at 5:30 P.M.. The next regular meeting of the Town Council will be held on Monday, September 8, 2008.
