

TOWN COUNCIL WORKSHOP  
TUESDAY, APRIL 6, 2010  
5:05 P.M.

Mayor Hensel called the workshop to order and present were; Councilmen Evans, Madsen & Shoemaker, Councilwoman Sluss. Also present were Clerk/Treasurer, Cindy Kahler, Deputy Clerk Treasurer, Sandy Lipps and Building Inspector, Steve Snook.

Mayor Hensel presented a draft Ordinance concerning covering loads of trash going to the landfill. He stated that the Ordinance would require that all loads of trash going to the landfill be tarped, covered with wire mesh or some other means to prevent materials from blowing or falling out of the vehicle. He indicated that he was opposed to tarping every load and he would like to see the word "cover" removed and replaced with the word "secure". There was a discussion concerning the various types of loads and the definition of "secure". There was some concern voiced regarding the landfill scale operators interpretation of "secured". The Ordinance would require that vehicles be charged extra for un-secured loads. The Council made minor changes and stated that they would like to see the Ordinance at the next Council meeting for first reading. There was a discussion concerning sign age and advertising being done prior to the final adopting of the Ordinance.

Building Inspector, Steve Snook presented some changes that were recently done by the State Legislature regarding the adoption of the new codes. He also stated that he would be required to be certified to do inspections for fire and life safety by July 1<sup>st</sup>. The Council agreed that he should move forward with the testing to get the certification. There was some discussion on turning fire and life safety over to the Fire Marshall's Office, however, the Council were in agreement they would like to keep it "in house" if possible.

Councilwoman Slubs stated that the Town Council and the County Commissioners needed to set a date for a workshop to discuss the feasibility study results that being done for a Community Center. The Council set May 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> as possible dates and Councilwoman Slubs will work on getting something set up.

Clerk/Treasurer, Cindy Kahler asked if anyone would be attending the lodging tax luncheon at Vimbos on Wednesday, and Councilman Shoemaker and Councilwoman Slubs volunteer to attend the luncheon. The Town will be holding "Clean Up" weed April 12<sup>th</sup> through the 17<sup>th</sup>. No one will be attending the WAR Convention in June in Evanston. Building Inspector Steve Snook stated that he normally goes, but he did not wish to go to the one in Evanston.
