RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS FOR THE
GOVERNING BODY OF THE
TOWN OF WHEATLAND

A special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Wheatland, Platte County, State of Wyoming was held in the Council Room of the Town Hall at 6:00 P.M., Monday, April 25, 2011.

Mayor Dixon called the meeting to order and upon roll call it was found that the following were present: Councilmen Madsen, Evans, Shoemaker and Graves. Also present were Town Clerk/Treasurer, Cindy Kahler and Deputy Clerk/Treasurer, Sandy Lipps.

Mayor Dixon opened a public hearing at 6:00 P.M. on a retail liquor license application transfer from Jimmy G. Wilson dba Wheatlanes to Wheatlanes. Deputy Clerk/Treasurer, Sandy Lipps stated that the Wyo. Liquor Commission is requiring the state sales tax license and the retail liquor license be in the same name. The liquor license has been Jimmy G. Wilson dba Wheatlanes and the sales tax license has been Wheatlanes, which is requiring a legal transfer of the liquor license. A motion was made by Councilman Evans and seconded by Councilman Shoemaker to approve the transfer of the retail liquor license from Jimmy G. Wilson dba Wheatlanes to Wheatlanes. Motion carried 4-0.

Mayor Dixon closed the public hearing on the retail liquor license transfer application from Jimmy G. Wilson dba Wheatlanes to Wheatlanes at 6:01 P.M.

Mayor Dixon presented a catering permit application from Dusty Boots for Thursday, April 28, 2011, at the 4-H building for an energy conference. A motion was made by Councilman Madsen and seconded by Councilman Graves to approve the catering permit application from Dusty Boots for April 28, 2011 at the 4-H building at the minimum fees allowed by law. Motion carried. 4-0.

With no further business to come before the Governing Body, Mayor Dixon adjourned the meeting at 6:02 P.M. The next regular meeting of the Town Council will be May 9, 2011.
