ADAMS, CHARLES SAMUEL July 29, 1842-November 21, 1927

Charles Samuel Adams, 85 years old, a resident of Wheatland for almost twenty-five years, passed away at 2 o'clock Monday afternoon, November 21. Mr. Adams had made his home several years with his son Lowell H. Adams.

The deceased was born July 29, 1842 in Groveland, Mass., the son of Moses and Sarah Colby Adams. He was married to Miss Eliza Ellen Simpson of Alna, Maine in 1866 at Georgetown, Maine, and they left immediately for Lyons, Ia., where they made their home until 1875, when they returned to the old home at Groveland. In 1881, they moved to Springfield, Mo., Mr. Adams came to Wheatland in 1903 and has lived here continuously since that time.

Mr. Adams was a carpenter by trade, had been a member of the Methodist church since early manhood. His wife passed away thirty-five years ago. Lowell H. Adams is the only one of six children living. The others were Fannie Amelia, Lena S. Cullie Root, Howard and Lawrence, the latter a twin of Lowell. There are fifteen grandchildren living.

The funeral was held at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon from the Methodist Episcopal church, the Rev. H.E. Shepherd officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery. The Watson Mortuary was in charge.
