

Funeral Services Were Held Here Monday Afternoon

Mrs. Ida Adams, mother of County Commissioner Claude E. Adams, passed away at the home of her son, Friday after an illness of considerable time. Mrs. Adams' condition had been critical for some time but she seemed to always rally until shortly before her death. Mrs. Adams was born in Kansas City, Kans., October 31, 1866 and was 68 years and 23 days of age at the time of her death. From Kansas City she moved with her parents to Boulder, Colo., where she grew to womanhood. She was united in marriage to George Sullivan Adams of Boulder on September 22 and they moved to the Wheatland community. To this union three children were born, Claude Edward, Bertha Irene and Florence Edna Weigand of Wheatland. There are also 11 grandchildren to survive her. Mr. Adams preceded his wife in death 12 years ago. Funeral services were held Monday afternoon at o'clock from the Congregational Church. Rev. R.E. Morrison was in charge of the services. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery with the Lola Watson Funeral Home in charge of the arrangements.
