

AGNEW, FLORENCE LILLIAN SIMPSON

December 10, 1857-August 25, 1944

Mrs. Florence L. Agnew, 86, resident of Wheatland since 1903, succumbed in the Wheatland General hospital Friday, August 25, where she had been confined for eleven days receiving treatment for a fractured hip.

Florence Lillian Simpson was born December 10, 1857 in Clarence, Ia., and was united in marriage to David B. Agnew on March 21, 1877 in Arcadia, Ia. To this union seven children were born. When her husband died in 1903 in LaJunta, Colo., she moved to Wheatland where she resided until her death. Mrs. Agnew was a member of the Congregational church, the Reading Circle and the W.T.K. club.

She is survived by five daughters, Mrs. Jessie Johnston of Los Angles, Calif.; Mrs. Edith Day of Riverside, Calif.; Mrs. S.H. Whitney of Sunrise; Mrs. Floss Hunton and Mrs. Ann Dearing of Wheatland; two sons, Frank of Los Angles, Calif. and Guy of Riverside, Calif.; a half-sister, Mrs. Mary Osborne of Iowa; eleven grandchildren and eight great grandchildren.

Funeral services were held in the Schrader chapel at 4 p.m. Sunday with the Rev. C.S. Higby officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery. Pallbearers included O.O. Natwick of Cheyenne, N.F. Hester, Ben Franzen, Harry Dearing, Arthur Rugg and Don Hunton.
