## Ona May Alloway

Funeral services for Ona May Alloway, 80, will be held Monday, Oct. 18, 1993, at 11 a.m. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with Gary Robbins, Pastor, officiating. Interment will follow in the Wheatland Cemetery.
