

ALMQUIST, ANDREW JOHN
February 2, 1855-June 2, 1942

Andrew John Almquist was born February 2, 1855, in Sweden. As a young man, he came to the United States, around the year '75. In 1883, March 14, he was united in marriage to Ida Christine Johnson in Cherokee, Iowa, where they made their home for a brief period later moving to Wyoming. Their life in Wyoming lasting almost 50 years in duration. He was a member of the Methodist church, having adopted that faith in Sweden. His was a life of courtesy, endeavor, christian in character and aims.

He was preceded in death by a son Theodore, and by his wife who passed away November 23, 1941. His daughter, Edith and a brother, Alfred Johnson of Hershey, Nebraska, and a niece and nephews living in Nebraska, survive him. A host of neighbors and other friends mourning his passing, came from 200 and 300 miles to do him honor. Among these was E.P. Baker of Boulder, Colorado. Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery by the side of his wife who so recently preceded him.
