

ALMQUIST, IDA CHRISTINE JOHNSON
September 22, 1860-November 23, 1941

Mrs. Andrew Almquist, 81, a resident of this community for over forty years, died at her home Sunday morning at 2:45.

Ida Christine Johnson was born in Sweden in 1860, September 22. As a young girl seventeen years of age, she came to the United States. On March 14, 1883, she was married to Andrew Almquist at Cherokee, Iowa, where they lived for some time, later moving to Wyoming.

She was a member of the Methodist church all her life, having accepted that faith in Sweden. She had a long and beautiful Christian life which many will remember.

Services were held November 25 at 2:00 p.m. from the Copley Mortuary with the Rev. C.B. Doughty in charge. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.

She was preceded in death by a son, Theodore. Survivors include her husband, Andrew, a daughter Edith, a brother-in-law, Alfred Johnson and wife of Hersey, Nebr.; two nieces, Mrs. Ida Runner and Mrs. Edna Haist, a nephew Lloyd Johnson and other relatives in Sweden.
