
Funeral Held Thursday For Nels P. Anderson

Nels Peter Andersen was born in Long Island, Denmark, Nov.2, 1854. He came to Brownwood, Texas in 1879, where in the surrounding country he found employment on the various cattle ranches.

He was married to Miss Clara Johnson in Fort Worth, Texas in 1887. To this union four children were born: Richard, who died in 1904; William, who lives in Wheatland; Alfred in New Mexico, and Mrs. Sidney Sturgeon of Rock River. Two grandsons and a host of friends survive him. His wife preceded him in death January 3, 1938.

Mr. Ancerson was a good father, a good friend and a good neighbor. He numbered his friends by his acquaintences. To know him was to love and admire him.

He moved with his family from Holdenville, Oklahoma in May of 1913 to his ranch 15 miles west of Wheatland. Here he and his family resided until a few months previous to Mrs. Andersen's death.
