

Charles Vernon Anderson

Memorial services for Guernsey, Wyoming, resident, Charles Vernon Anderson, 69, will be conducted at 5:00 P.M. on Thursday, July 29, 2004, in the downstairs conference room of Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Father Jan Santich of Saint Patrick Catholic Church officiating. Cremation has taken place.

Mr. Anderson died Wednesday, July 21, 2004, at Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Charles was born February 20, 1935, in Lingle, Wyoming, the son of Milton W. "Swede" and Iva Margie (Whipple) Anderson. He was reared in the communities of Lingle and Fort Laramie, Wyoming. Charles worked as a farmhand, in a lumber-hardware business, and as a seismologist prior to being employed by the City of Torrington.
