

ANDERSON, SIDNEY CHRISTIAN  
1876-March 7, 1953

Sidney Christian Anderson, 77, died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Robert Daly, at the Daly ranch on Horseshoe near Glendo Saturday, March 7, after an illness of only a few days.

Mr. Anderson was a former resident of Saratoga, but came to Glendo last fall to make his home with his daughter. He had followed railroad construction work all of his adult life, having been employed as superintendent of construction for the Northern Pacific and the Canadian Pacific railroads. He was retired from work in 1933.

The deceased was a native of Sweden. After coming to this country, he attended school at Ironwood, Mich., and also the University of Minnesota.

Other survivors besides Mrs. Daly include another daughter, Mrs. Willard Carlyle and a son, Sidney C., both of Minneapolis, Minn. He also leaves a sister, Mrs. Ebba Smith at Edmonton, Alberta, Canada and six grandchildren and five great grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Wednesday at 2 p.m. from the Schrader Funeral home with the Rev. C.E. Tilford of Guernsey officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery. Pallbearers were Larry Daly, Patrick Daly, John Hughes, Clyde Cundall, Clayton Russell and Oscar Rogers.
