

ANGEL, JENNY BARHAUG
February 5, 1912-September 25, 1971

Jenny Angel died September 25, 1971 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital.

Mrs. Angel was born in Chicago, Illinois on Feb. 5, 1912 and was united in marriage to N.C. Angel December 20, 1940 in Casper. Prior to moving to Wheatland in 1968, the Angels lived in Ft. Hauchuca, Arizona where Col Angel was stationed. While there, Mrs. Angel was Honorary President of the Ft. Hauchuca officers' wives club, and was a member of various women's military clubs. Following Col. Angel's retirement, the family moved to Wheatland where he became the Director of the Platte County Dept. of Public Assistance and Social Services until August 1, 1971 when he was transferred to Cheyenne.

Survivors of the deceased include her husband, N.C. Angel, Cheyenne; three sons, Ronald Cutts, Casper, Philip Angel, in the military service and Christopher Angel, University of Wyoming, Laramie; her mother, Mrs. H.O. Barhaug, Wheatland; one brother, Rug Barhaug, Casper; one sister, Mrs. Laurence Swallow, Wheatland and four grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Monday, September 27, 1971, at 2:00 p.m. at the Schrader Chapel with Rev. Henry Hartberg officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery. Serving as pallbearers were Ed Kendig, Casmer Isabell, John Allen, Russell Bovaird, Joe Gloyd and John Mylet.
