Services for James Beal Angle Jr., 69, were Saturday, Feb. 22 at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with Pastor Mark Patzke of the Covenant Lutheran Church officiating. Interment was at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Angle died Tuesday Feb. 18th at his home in Wheatland following a sudden illness.
