

ARMANN, FRANK

November 16, 1868-March 28, 1952

Born in Portsmouth, Ohio, November 16, 1869, Frank Armann died March 28, 1952 at the Wheatland hospital following an illness of two weeks. He was 83 years of age.

A retired farmer, he had lived in this community for 53 years. He was a member of the Wheatland Odd Fellows Lodge.

Surviving Mr. Armann is his wife, Della Mae, three step-daughters, Hazel Reerink, Juanita Terry and Vera McGuire, all of Wheatland; one sister, Mrs. Dora Betten, Adams, Nebr.; two half-brothers, Henry Armann, Martell, Nebr., and John Livingston, Lincoln, Nebr.; six grandchildren and four great grandchildren.

Services were held Monday at 2 p.m. in the Schrader Chapel, Rev. J.B. Milstead officiating. Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery, with the Odd Fellows Lodge conducting graveside services.
