

ARNOLD, ALBERTA CLEMA ISABELL
December 25, 1909- September 14, 1955

Death came to Mrs. Alberta Clema Isabell Arnold, wife of Edgar Arnold of San Diego, Calif., on Wednesday, September 14, after an extended illness. She died in the Sharp Memorial hospital in San Diego at the age of 45. Born in Omaha, Nebr., December 25, 1909, Mrs. Arnold was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Sam Isabell of Wheatland. She attended Wheatland schools and was affiliated with the Christian church. Leaving Wheatland in 1948, the deceased lived three years in Denver before the family moved to San Diego where they have resided since 1941.

Funeral services were held in Wheatland Tuesday, September 20, at 2 p.m., at the Christian church, with Mr. Floyd Hopper, minister of the church officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.
