

ARTERY, JOSEPH WILLIAM  
January 6, 1872-July 6, 1944

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon in the Methodist church for Joseph W. Artery, 72, who died of a sudden heart attack in the State bank last Thursday afternoon. The Rev. W.W. Maxwell officiated, and Mrs. Robert Kuns and Robert Barnes, accompanied by Mrs. J.A. Bohmont, sang.

Joseph William Artery was born in Greentop, Mo. on January 6, 1872 and was united in marriage to Miss Cora Elizabeth Bruce on December 11, 1893 in Oberlin, Kansas. To this union three daughters and four sons were born. Mr. Artery retired from farming six years ago and he and his wife moved from Kansas to Wheatland where they have since made their home.

Besides his wife, he is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Cleeta Studer, Mrs. Helen Borthwick, and Mrs. Elaine Neeley, all of Wheatland; four sons, Glen of Manderson, Wyo., Floyd and Alvie of Oberlin, Kan., and Renzo, who has been serving in the armed forces in the Aleutians for Wheatland an hour after his father's death.
