

ARTIST, CLAUDINE ALMYRA
October 24, 1879-October 8, 1969

Funeral services for Claudine A. Artist, 89, were held Sat., Oct. 11, at 2:00 p.m. at the United Church of Christ with Rev. Clare E. Olney officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery. Pallbearers were Ed Foreman, Doyle Hutchinson, W.I. Sutherland, Lowell Clark, Orvel Bridgmon and Zack Phifer.

Mrs. Artist died Wed., Oct. 8 at the Davis Nursing Home in Denver after an extended illness. She was born in Paola, Kans. on Oct. 24, 1879 and had lived in Wheatland many years before moving to Denver six years ago. She was affiliated with the Congregational Church and belonged to the Order of the Eastern Star and the Dorcas Society.

Survivors include one son, Alva A. Artist, Crockett, Calif.; and a daughter, Mrs. Lois A. Carlson of Denver; five grandchildren and nine great grandchildren. Her husband Charles Edward Artist preceded her in death on July 27, 1964.
