

ASHENHURST, VIOLA MAE ISABELL

May 25, 1929-January 9, 1955

Mrs. Gene Ashenhurst, a 25-year old native of Wheatland, died in Lincoln General hospital, Lincoln, Nebr., Sunday. A resident of Forsyth, Mont., Mrs. Ashenhurst became ill three weeks ago, and was flown to Lincoln after being hospitalized in Montana.

She is survived by her husband, Gene, and three small daughters, Connie, 4, Christie, 3, and Caren, 1; her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Sam Isabell, Sr. of Wheatland; two brothers, Casmer and Samuel, Jr. of Wheatland; four sisters, Mrs. Pearl Lawrence, Wheatland, Mrs. Alberta Arnold, LaMesa, Calif.; Mrs. Delores Christensen, Bozeman, Mont. and Mrs. Lillie Edmiston, Casper. Two sisters and one brother preceded her in death.

States Telephone and Telegraph company and at Penney's before moving to Montana. She was married to Gene Ashenhurst January 3, 1950. Mrs. Ashenhurst was a member of the Christian church.
