

ASHER, CECILE MAY MARTIN
October 13, 1890-August 2, 1957

Funeral services were held Tuesday at 2:00 p.m. from the Congregational Church in Wheatland for Cecile May Asher, 66, of Fontana, Calif., mother of Mrs. Darrow Blow.

Mrs. Asher was born October 13, 1890 in Nebraska and passed away in San Bernardino Hospital, San Bernardino, Calif., August 2, 1957, following an illness of one week. She was the daughter of Frank A. and Etta Johnson Martin and taught school in Slater and Wheatland years ago.
