

ATKINSON, JAMES F.

1872-July 9, 1950

A resident of Wyoming for 68 years, James Atkinson, 77, Uva rancher, died Sunday at the home of his son, James F. Atkinson, Jr.

Services were held at 2 p.m. Thursday in the Congregational church at Wheatland with the Rev. J.B. Milstead officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland cemetery.

Born in Yorkshire, England, Mr. Atkinson came to Laramie with his parents at the age of nine. For a short time, they lived on a ranch on Duck Creek and later moved to a ranch on the North Laramie river, near Garrett, where he lived for the past 55 years.

Survivors include his wife, Jennie, three sons, William S. of Hanna, Thomas D. of Garrett, and James F. Atkinson of Jay Em. He is also survived by a daughter, Katie Corl of Garrett; one brother, William of Laramie, and five grandchildren.

Pallbearers were Tom Dodge, Tom McGill, and Byron Fish, all of Wheatland, John Guthrie of Laramie, Walt Robinson of Glendo, and Harry Dunlap of Garrett.
