

BABB, LEN L., SR.
July 2, 1893-January 13, 1968

Funeral services for Len L. Babb, Sr., 74, were held Tuesday, Jan. 16 at 10:00 a.m. from the Reformed Church of the Latter Day Saints. Elder Forrest Julius conducted the services and burial was in the Wheatland cemetery. Dr. H.D. Schroeder, Pat Daly, Loren Ramsey, Stanley Starr, Ralph Poe and Zane Geis served as pallbearers.

Mr. Babb passed away on January 13th at the Platte Memorial hospital following a sudden illness. He was born July 2, 1893 in Stanton, Nebr. He married Bessie Hazel Dickinson Nov. 11, 1924, in Madison, Nebr. He had been a resident of this community since 1946, prior to that he had lived in South Dakota. Mr. Babb was a veteran of World War I and was affiliated with the Reorganized Church of the Latter Day Saints.
