

BACH, ALBERT FRED
February 8, 1920-July 16, 1952

Services were held Tuesday, July 22, at the Methodist church for Albert F. Bach, who died July 16, 1952, in Santa Barbara, California following two weeks illness. Mr. Bach is the son of Mr. and Mrs. George Bach of Wheatland and was living in Bakersfield, California where he was in the garage business. He was born Feb. 8, 1920 in Prairie View, Kansas, and had made his home in Kansas prior to moving to California. He was a veteran of World War II and a member of the Christian Reform Church.
