Albert Edward Barrett died Thursday, Nov. 15, 1979 at the age of 87, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital. Funeral services were held Monday, Nov. 19, 1979, at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Daniel Barcus officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
