

## Ruth Donna Belden

May 6, 1913 - September 13, 2005

A service of Christian burial for Ruth Donna Belden, 92, was conducted at 10 a.m. on Friday, Sept. 16, 2005, at All Saints' Episcopal Church in Wheatland, with the Reverends Lori Modesitt and Joel Dingman officiating. Inurnment was in the Wheatland Cemetery at Wheatland.

She died Tuesday, Sept. 13, at Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Ruth was born May 6, 1913, in Gage County, Neb., the daughter of Alice (Ellis) and Everett L. Jimerson. She was reared and educated in Morrill County, Neb.; and married Wallace Benjamin Belden Sr. on June 21, 1930, in Torrington. They farmed in Nebraska before moving to Wheatland in 1944; and, ranched and farmed in the Wheatland area for many years. Ruth cooked at the school and in several restaurants over the years as well as cooking for family and friends, which she loved to do. She was a member of the Bordeau Good Luck Club, Cottonwood Club, All Saints' Episcopal Church and the Altar Guild. Ruth had the gift of hospitality and her door was always open to family and friends. She enjoyed playing games, sewing, cooking, was an avid reader, and loved babies.
