

BIBBEY, FLETCHER

November 3, 1867-January 14, 1926

Fletcher Bibbey, resident of the Dwyer and Wheatland districts for the past eight years, died Thursday, Jan. 14, at his home on the Yellowstone highway three miles south of Wheatland, after a long illness, at the age of 58 years.

Mr. Bibbey was born Nov. 3, 1867 in Jones county, Iowa. He was married in 1890 to Miss Ida Priest of Leon, Iowa. To this union, 10 children were born, of whom five are still living: Mrs. Elsie Brewer of Corydon, Iowa; Mrs. Gertie Coffey of Bixby, Okla.; and Roy Bibbey, Robert Bibbey and Eldon Bibbey of Wheatland. There also survives six brothers and sisters: Owen Bibbey of Redland, Calif.; Myra Boswell of Long Beach, Calif.; Alice Bedwell of Ventura, Calif.; Ella Hodesheldt of Cincinnati, Iowa; Mervin Bibbey of Davis City, Iowa, and Carrie Bibbey of Dwyer.

He came to Wyoming Jan. 1, 1918, engaging in the dairy business on a farm between Guernsey and Dwyer. In March of last year, he moved on the old Webster farm south of Wheatland, where he died.

He was first stricken last July with the illness that had carried him away and had been bedfast since Thanksgiving. The funeral was held at the Christian Church, January 17. Rev. W.H. Lyman conducting the services. The Times joins the community in extending sympathy to his widow and family.
