Michael Lloyd Bise, 32, passed away on Saturday, July 2, 2022, at St. Joseph's Hospital in Phoenix, Arizona. In April, 2019, Michael received a double lung transplant at the Norton Thoracic Institute, in Phoenix.

Following his transplant, Michael was able to enjoy three years living his life, working his trade as an electrician, with his work family at Amped Electric, and enjoying his family and children, Carter, Sierra, and Harper. Because of a second chance at life, he experienced the birth of his third child, Harper, who arrived just three weeks after his transplant.

Michael was born on Thursday, October 5, 1989, in Wheatland, the son of Howard and Peggy Bise. Growing, Michael thrived in the wide-open spaces on the Slater Flats. Michael had the camaraderie with his cousins doing "boy things," fireworks, hunting, and playing cowboys and Indians. Michael and his dad, Howard, had a passion for guns and shooting them. It was never determined who was the better marksman, Michael or Howard! In his quieter moments, he liked to read and performed well in his school work.

At an early age, Michael accepted the Lord Jesus, and began praying for a baby brother. Two years later his prayers were answered, and the family was blessed with Stephen. Michael enjoyed being the big brother, teaching Stephen "boy things."

As a young adult Michael pursued the trade of an electrician, and received his Journeyman's License through Eastern Wyoming College, in Torrington, Wyoming. During this time, he met Marisha Snell, and son, Carter.

Michael and Marisha were married on June 19, 2010, in Wheatland. Michael and Marisha and son, Carter, added to their family when a daughter, Sierra, was born in 2011, and Harper, in 2019. Mike and his family enjoyed outings to Snowy Range and rides up to Laramie Peak Mountain. Mike's passion for guns never subsided, always being in relentless pursuit of another one, which included pestering his wife! Michael was proud of his family and always thought he wanted more children in the future.

Michael fought a courageous battle with his health during the past three years, with his wife and family always close by his side. Surviving Michael is his wife, Marisha, of 12 years; children, Carter, Sierra, and Harper; his mother, Peggy Bise; father and mother-in-law, Gene and Angie Snell; and Yennefer his German Shepherd.

Preceding him in death is his father, Howard Bise and brother, Stephen Bise.
