## BOWEN, MEREDITH JEAN RUNYAN August 4, 1922-November 7, 2010

A memorial service to celebrate the life of Meredith "Jean" Bowen, 88, will be conducted at 11:00 A.M., Friday, November 19, 2010, at the First Christian Church, in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Pastor Andy Gudahl officiating.

She died Sunday, November 7, 2010, at the Platte County Memorial Nursing Home in Wheatland.

Jean was born August 4, 1922 in Wheatland, Wyoming to Ross Henry and Cora Belle (Phelps) Runyan. Due to her parents' business ventures, she lived in several Wyoming communities. She also enjoyed the sunny beaches of Hawaii and the desert weather of Arizona in the wintertime. Having her family come together during the holiday seasons gave her much comfort and joy.

Survivors include three children, Robert (Dixie Lee) Bowen of Cheyenne, Wyoming, Rick (Shelly) Bowen of Wheatland, and Deb (Bob) Meredith of Casa Grande, Arizona; seven grandchildren, Kristina (Christian) Kelker of Lancaster, Pennsylvania, Robert (Megan) Bowen of Carthage, New York, Oliver (Dawn) Bowen of Tucson, Arizona, Todd (Tana) Howard of Cheyenne, Rikki (Cody) Thies of Gillette, Wyoming, and MacKenzie and Tricia Martin of Wheatland; six great-grandchildren, Elizabeth Kelker, Ben and Lily Jean Bowen, Tracen and Tripp Howard, and Avery Thies.
