

John Jacob Brecht, 87, longtime resident and farmer of Platte Co., died at the Platte Co. Memorial Nursing Home, Wheatland, Thursday, Aug. 22.

He was the son of John and Mary Brecht. Born April 19, 1889, in a German settlement in Russia, he came to the United States when he was seven years of age. The family homesteaded in Alliance, Neb. There, he grew up and married Ethel Swanson. She died in 1964. They moved to Chicago, Ill. in 1924 where he worked for years as an operator for the utility company. They later moved to

Wheatland and began farming. He was a resident of the nursing home for the last two years.
