Funeral services for Shirley Lynn Brown, 57, will be held Wednesday, July 29, at 10:30 a.m. at the United Church of Christ in Wheatland, Wyo. with Pastor Ken Saunders officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.
