BROWN, WILLIAM H. September 12, 1868-July 26, 1941

William H. Brown, 78, resident of Goshen county since 1910, passed away in Wheatland, Saturday, July 26.

William Brown was born in Gasper county, Indiana, Sept. 12, 1863, and when a small boy, moved with his parents to a farm in Marion county, Iowa where he grew to manhood. The twenty-five years in Iowa before he moved west were devoted to the care of an invalid father who passed away in 1909.

In 1910, Mr. Brown, accompanied by his sister, Mrs. Elizabeth Tidball, to Goshen county where they located on adjoining homesteads among a colony of people who were settling the new country from Marion county. For several years he conducted a general store in the Lakeview settlement and Mrs. Tidball served as postmistress. Both were active in the social life of the community and both gave their time and effort to the support of the little church and Sunday school of the settlement. After his sister's death in 1925, Mr. Brown moved to Wheatland where he resided until his death.

Services were held Tuesday, July 29, at 2 o'clock at the Copley Funeral Home with Rev. Waddell officiating. There are no survivors.
