

## Edgar B. Burns

Private family graveside services and interment will be held for Edgar B. Burns, 85, at the Wheatland Cemetery with Dan Driggs, Minister, officiating.

Mr. Burns died Saturday, May 14, 1994, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

He was born May 14, 1909 in Winchester, Okla., the son of Carl and Alma (Houston) Burns. He was reared and educated in Oklahoma, and then as a teenager he moved to Wyoming, living in Goshen County and Wheatland. He had many jobs during his career, such as teaching at rural schools, as a ranch hand for the von Forell Ranch, and as a carpenter and plumber until his retirement.

He was married to Elsie Kerns on May 23, 1937 in Wheatland. During World War II, they lived in California, and then moved back to Wheatland following the war. He had since resided in Wheatland until the time of his death. He loved to grow flowers and work in his garden.

He is survived by his wife, Elsie, of Wheatland, a son and daughter-in-law, Don and Marilyn Burns of Loveland, Colo., and a daughter-in-law, Beverly Burns of Wheatland. Also surviving are a sister, Mildred Monroe of Broadus, Mont., a brother, Bob Burns of Grand Junction, Colo., five grandchildren, Heath Burns, Renee' Isabell and Ross Burns, all of Wheatland, and Chris Burns and Stephanie Burns, both of Loveland, Colo., and two great-grandchildren, Ronald Isabell and Heather Isabell, both of Wheatland.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one son, Ron Burns, on Jan. 28, 1994, and two brothers.
