

William Burzlaff 1980

William Charles Burzlaff passed away Jan. 30, 1980 in Wheatland at the age of 60.

Bill Burzlaff was born June 19, 1919 in Dodge Center, Minn., the son of William and Clara Burzlaff. When he was six years old, he came to Wyoming with his family. He attended schools in Wheatland, graduating in 1938 from Wheatland High School.

He entered the U. S. Army Air Corps and served in the European Theater during World War II. When he was discharged from the military, he returned to Wheatland and started dairy farming. He operated his farm until ill health forced his retirement in August of 1975.

Bill is survived by his wife, Ella of Wheatland; one son, Russell,

who is now operating the dairy farm; two daughters, Karen Brakel and Janet Schneider, both of Longmont, Colo.; two brothers, Lawrence of Casper and Donald of Texas; one sister, Maxine Sherwood of Wheatland and four grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Feb. 5 at the Trinity Lutheran Church with Pastor Emmet Rogness officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

A memorial has been established in his name to the Trinity Lutheran Church in Wheatland.
