Wyoma Baker was born on Saturday, June 25, 1938 the daughter of James Otis and Hazel Lucille (Curtis) Valentine.

Wyoma was reared and educated in Wheatland and graduated from Wheatland High School in 1956. She worked and operated the ranches in Antelope Gap and Goshen Hole areas.
