CHADWICK, FRANK B. 1859-1930

Frank B. Chadwick, 71 year old Wyoming pioneer, passed away at Evanston Tuesday morning at the age of 71 years.

His body was shipped to Wheatland and will arrive tonight. Funeral services will be held tomorrow afternoon at the Watson Mortuary chapel at two o'clock and burial will be held in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mr. Chadwick was born in Wisconsin and at the age of 18, trailed a bunch of cattle from Oregon to Wyoming for his first visit to this state. Soon after that, he settled in the neighborhood of Cheyenne and in 1901 came to Wheatland and took up a ranch on Hallick creek. While living here, he engaged in both cattle raising and mining.

The deceased is survived by his wife, three daughters, Mrs. Ellen Whalen and Mrs. Carrie Porter of El Cerito, Calif., and Mrs. H.T. Dyott of Baltimore, Md.; two sons, Ben of Wheatland and Harry of Sheridan and one sister, Mrs. Kate Hopkins of Maine. Harry was the only one, away from Wheatland, that was able to attend the funeral.
