He attended the Pleasant View (Axford) School through the eighth grade and graduated from Wheatland High School in 1936; then attended the University of Wyoming at Laramie for one year. In 1966, he and his wife moved to Jackson, Wyoming, where he worked as a cashier at the Jackson State Bank; retiring in 1985 as Vice President-Cashier. In early 2002, Leo returned to Wheatland following the death of his wife and resided at Country

Club Living until the fall of 2004 when he became a resident of the Platte County Memorial Nursing Home. He was a past member of the Redeemer Lutheran Church in Jackson and the Wyoming Banker's Association and was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Wheatland.

Leo is survived by three nephews, Edward E. Chase of Casper, Wyoming, Kenneth Chase of San Diego, California, and Charles J. "Jim" Chase of Laramie; several great nieces and nephews; and many friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Frieda on October 7,
