July 6, 1925-June 2, 1942

Carol Vianna Clark was born at Wheatland July 6, 1925. She died at the hospital Tuesday, June 2, 1942. Her death was caused by a basal skull fracture, the result of a fall. She had just completed here junior year at Wheatland high school. She had exceptional musical and artistic ability and won county poster contests repeatedly.
