

9-1-1989 Lela Marie Cochran Services for Lela Marie Cochran, 94, who died in Wheatland Sept. 1, 1988, were held Saturday, Sept. 3, 1988, in the Frontier Baptist Church in Wheatland at 1:30 p.m. with Dan Barcus, minister.

Born July 9, 1894, in Medford, Iowa, she was the daughter of James and Margaret (Weaver) Harsh. She and Guy Cochran were married in Iowa, March 20, 1913. In 1928 they moved to Wheatland where they farmed west of town. They farmed until Guy's death in 1971. In 1973 Lela moved into town where she spent her retirement years.
