## **Esther Fern Randall-Coe**

Graveside services and interment for Esther Fern Randall-Coe, 93, were held Tuesday, October 8th 2002, at 11:00 a.m. in the Wheatland Cemetery at Wheatland, Wyoming, with Andy Gudahl, Minister of the First Christian Church officiating.

Mrs. Coe died Saturday, September 28th, 2002, in Bullhead City, Arizona.
