## Local man killed when hit by train

Death came suddenly to Jack Connor, 75 of Wheatland, a retire rancher, when a northbound CB & freight train passed over his bodi about 12:20 Wednesday morning just east of the Wheatland Lumber Co.

Reporting officials investigating the accident stated that the Engineer D. P. Lewis, of Cheyenne, had noticed something on the tracks ahead and thought it to be a large piece of paper. After three cars had passed over the body the train was stopped. It was stated that the train was traveling at about 18 miles an hour.

Full details are not known and an inquest is pending. Services
