Funeral services for John William "Bill" Consonver, 80, were held Tuesday, July 26, 1994 at 2 p.m. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with the Rev. Linda Patzke of the Wheatland United Methodist Church officiating. Inurnment followed in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Consoliver died Saturday, July 23, 1994 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland. He was born March 4, 1914 in Stanberry, Mo., the son of Lewis Elza and Della May (Reed) Consoliver. He moved with his parents to Torrington in 1919, and then on to Riverton in 1922, where the family remained and he finished his education.

He served in the 32nd Special Navy Seabees in the

Philippine Islands in World War II.

On Dec. 24, 1949. he was married to Myrtle F. Jordan, of Wheatland, at Lusk, Wyo. They made their home in Wheatland where he worked several years before retiring from the Wheatland Irrigation District office. He was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, and he enjoyed fishing, hunting and doing woodwork.

He is survived by his wife, Myrtle, of Wheatland, and one daughter, Mary, and her husband, LeRoy McCartney of Wheatland. Also surviving are a brother, Robert Consoliver of Phoenix, Ariz., three sisters, Mary Hatch of Colorado Springs, Colo., Gertrude Raymond of Springfield, Ore., and Ivadell Thaxton of Portland, Ore., and two grandchildren, Brett and Brandon McCartney, both of Wheatland.

He was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers, Ralph Consoliver and Harold Consoliver.
