

Leona H. Daly

GLENDON — Funeral services for Leona H. Daly, 87, will be held Monday at 2 p.m. at the Glendo Community Church with Dan Barcus, minister officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Daly died July 23, 1993, at her home in Glendo.

She was born March 10, 1906, in Duluth, Minn., the daughter of Sidney C. and Emma C. (Block) Anderson. The family moved for a time to Spokane, Wash., where she received her early education. Then they moved to Minneapolis, Minn., where she graduated from the University of Minnesota. She worked for a time with the Girl Scouts in northern Minnesota and had her first teaching position in Fremont, Neb.

She married Robert W. Day in Red Lodge, Mont., on Aug. 8, 1932, and joined him in Wyoming at the end of the school year. They lived in Minnesota for five years and returned to Wyoming living in Laramie, Guernsey, and Glendo,

where Mrs. Daly lived until her death.

She taught school for over 20 years and retired in the late 1960s. She was a 40-year member of the Glendo Women's Benefit Club and the Farm Bureau. She enjoyed crocheting, reading, and doing crossword puzzles.

Survivors include three children, Patricia Archie and John T. Daly of Glendo, and Dennis R. Daly of Douglas; seven grandchildren; nine great-grandchildren; and two foster grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, and a brother and sister, Grace Carlisle and Calvin Anderson.
