

DANCULOVICH, DONNA MARGURITE PITCHER

October 27, 1934-July 20, 1977

Last rites were held Saturday, July 23, 1977, for Donna Margurite Danculovich at the Assembly of God Church with Rev. C.W. Livers officiating. Interment was at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Danculovich died suddenly in her home Wednesday, July 20, 1977, at the age of 42. She was born October 27, 1934 in Wheatland. After her marriage to David Danculovich May 10, 1953, in Wheatland, the couple moved around the United States to various areas where he was employed with the U.S. Government Geological Survey. She settled in Wheatland in 1972 and has lived here until the time of her death. She was employed by the Ben Franklin store.
