

# Judith Ann Dannar

May 1, 1925 – April 20, 2011

Graveside services for Judith Ann Dannar, 85, were held at 10:30 A.M. Saturday, April 23, 2011 at the Wheatland Cemetery in Wheatland, Wyoming with Reverend Jill Zimmerschied with the All Saints Episcopal Church officiating.

Judith died Wednesday, April 20, 2011 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

She was born May 1, 1925 in Rochester, Minnesota the daughter of Edwin E. and Alice (Holt) Lietz. The Lietz family moved from Eyota, Minnesota to Wheatland in 1936. They purchased the Commercial Hotel known as the LaRamie Hotel Bar & Lounge and a farm outside of town, where the Wheatland Bible Church is now located. She graduated from Wheatland High School, and then attended Stephens College in Columbus, Missouri, where she earned a private Pilot's License. Rex. After managing the LaRamie Hotel and later the West Winds Motel, she became the office manager and bookkeeper for Lindstrom, Inc.
