

DAVIDSON, WILLIAM L.
January 6, 1883-March 27, 1954.

William L. Davidson of Wheatland died Saturday, March 27, following an illness of two weeks' duration. A resident of the community for twenty-two years, Mr. Davidson is survived by his wife Janet; a son John William Davidson of Wichita, Kans.; two step-daughters, Mrs. Willard Collins and Mrs. John Farber, both of Cheyenne; two sisters, Mrs. Mandane Smith of Independence, Kans. and Mrs. Crystal Reed of Fairbury, Nebr.; a brother, Frank Davidson of Independence, Kans. and four grandchildren.

The Rev. Irvin C. Noyce presided at the funeral services held Wednesday afternoon at two o'clock at the Schrader chapel. Pallbearers were Herbert Percy, Gordon Davis, Al Johnson, Kenneth Barnes, Leonard Weber and Frank Scott.

Mr. Davidson's parents were Sam and Polly Davidson. He was born in Hoxie, Kans. January 6, 1883, where he continued to make his home until he came to Wheatland in 1932. Mr. and Mrs. Davidson operated a dry cleaning service for 18 years here. He also served for a time as justice of the peace and was a member of the IOOF lodge.
