Funeral services for Patrick Rom Davies, 35, were held Wednesday, Oct. 15 at 2 p.m. at the First Christian Church in Wheatland with Pastor Andy Gudahl officiating. Internment was at the Wheatland Cemetery with military honors accorded.

Mr. Davies died in Wheatland on Saturday, Oct. 11.

He was born June 9, 1968 in Douglas, Wyo., the son of Elias Erwin "Shorty" and Nancy (Norton) Davies. He was reared and educated in Wheatland, graduating from the Wheatland High School in 1986. He worked for True Ranches following graduation. He then entered the United States Marine Corps serving for four years, he was involved with the Persian Gulf War. Following his discharge from the Marines he attended the San Bernardino Sheriff Academy in California, and then became a police officer with Rialto Department in California for two years. He moved back to Cheyenne where he worked at various jobs in the area. He was married to Sonja K. Donnelly on July 4, 1998 in Cheyenne. They moved to Wheatland in 1999, and he worked in the natural gas fields throughout Wyoming. He enjoyed fishing, camping, football, and playing video games. He was member of the Moose Lodge.

He is survived by his wife, Sonja K. Davies, of Wheatland; his mother, Nancy Davies, of Cheyenne; five children, Beau Allen Davies of Pace, Fla., Maria Brady Davies, Tara Donnelly Davies, Kirstie Jeanette Thomas, and Stevie Lee Beckner all of Wheatland; two brothers, Robert Jay Davies of Wichita, Kan., and Timothy Paul Davies of Rock Springs; maternal grandmother, Rose Norton of Otto, N.C.; and paternal grandmother, Edna Davies of Douglas.

He was preceded in death by his father, Shorty on Oct. 9, 1991; maternal grandfather, Jay Norton; and maternal grandfather, Walter Davies.
